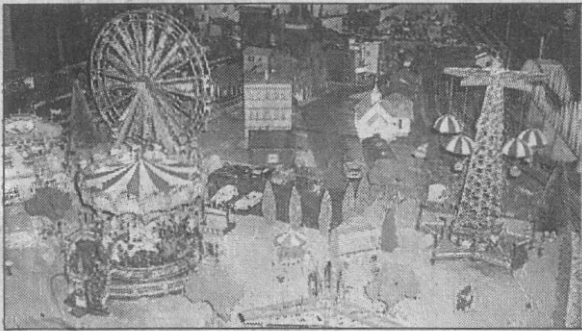


ACROSS THE AREA
